Practice	One (1) session will be held as defined in the Timetable.			
Qualifying	There will be Timed Qualifying at this Event.			
	Qualifying will be split into two (2) groups of Karts. Pro Class and Champ Class.			
	Each group will have one (1) Timed Qualifying Session of eight (8) minutes.			
Starting Grid	Will be as per the Endurance Regulations – Section 4E.8.7.			
	The following breaches will also result in a Rear of Grid starting position:			
	a) Karts still within Pit Lane or the Paddock when pit lane exit closes (refer to the			
	Meeting Timetable below).			
	b) Karts still in Pit Lane when the exit closes for the Race start.			
	c) Karts removed from Pit Lane for any reason during or after Qualifying.			
	d) Any team that carries out work to their Kart after Qualifying, other than			
	adjustments of Weights or Tyre pressures.			
Race	The Event will consist of one (1) Race only.			
	The Race will be a time certain finish of Six (6) hours.

	The Race will commence with a Standing Start.
	There will be a minimum of Two (2) Fuel Stops made, in the total of Nine (9)
	compulsory Pit Stops during the Race. The stop at the end of the Race is not
	included.
	The minimum number of Drivers per Kart is Two (2)
Pit Lane	Speed limits will apply as per the Endurance Regulations. The minimum Pit Stop Time will be announced and displayed before the 12.40pm Drivers Briefing commences. Pit stop times will be extended to facilitate the cleaning of equipment prior to a driver change. Social distancing requirements must be adhered to (1.5m). No more than two (2) team members (including the driver) to be in pit lane at any time. Team members within the pit area must be wearing long pants, a long sleeve shirt and gloves at all times.
	Karts waiting to exit pit lane must wait behind the red line adjacent to the pit transition timing screen. A kart or karts that are identified as waiting beyond the red line or blocking the exit of pit lane will have a one (1) minute time penalty applied at the end of the race. A second offence on the same day will have a 10 lap penalty applied at the end of the race.
Fuel Bay	The Fuel Bay is closed for the first thirty (30) minutes and last thirty (30) minutes of the Race. Announcements will be made regarding this.
Virtual Safety Kart	A Full course Yellow (Virtual Safety Kart) may be used at the discretion of the Clerk of Course. Spacing between karts of 1.0m is to be maintained at all times when karts are in motion. If directed to come to a stop on the circuit, spacing of 2.0m will be required.
Driving Time Limits	Driving Time Limits must be observed as per the Endurance Regulations.
Post Race Parc Ferme	All karts will remain in Parc Ferme at the conclusion of the event until the Clerk of Course (C.O.C.) approves their release. The release will not be granted until the C.O.C. is satisfied that the track surface and grounds have been satisfactorily cleaned and the Club President is satisfied that the club's equipment has been packed up in the club trailer.

E. MEETING CONDITIONS

COVID-19 & SOCIAL DISTANCING:

All persons entering the circuit will be required to adhere with:

- 1. NSW Public Health Orders current at the commencement of the event
- 2. Karting NSW COVID-19 Management Plan
- 3. Four Stroke Karting Association of NSW COVID-19 Management Plan

The event shall not be authorised to commence until the Chief Steward and Clerk of the Course (jointly) complete the KNSW Covid-19 Race Day Checklist.

Failure to comply with this requirement may result on the associated team being ejected from the circuit.

TYRES:

Any number of Tyres may be used in Practice Sessions.

Once the Endurance Race commences, only one (1) set of the prescribed Dry Weather Tyres, and

two (2) sets of the prescribed Wet Weather Tyres may be used for the duration of the Event.

CONTROL FUEL:

Control Fuel Will be used at this Meeting.

Caltex Vortex 95 Fuel must be purchased and used at this Meeting.

The Fuel must be purchased from any Caltex or Woolworths-Caltex service station.

You will need to purchase Twenty Three (23) litres of Fuel for each Kart.

Fuel is to be purchased no more than two (2) days prior to the start of the Meeting. Proof of purchase of the Fuel must be retained and produced to the Chief Scrutineer or Fuel Marshal if required.

Before the Endurance Race, once the Fuel Bay opens, all Karts must be presented with empty Fuel tanks. After receiving their Fuel, Karts are to remain in Parc Ferme, under direction of the Officials.

Competitors/Pit Crew may continue to work on their Karts whilst in Parc Ferme.

FUEL TANK:

All Karts must only be fitted with one (1) Fuel tank.

A maximum of one (1) hand operated in-line Fuel Primer Bulb is permitted per Engine.

The maximum Fuel capacity of all filters (in total) is not to exceed 60ml.

All Fuel line must be a maximum ID of 6.35mm or ¼ inch.

TECHNICAL:

Dynamic steering is not permitted in this category. Karts fitted with dynamic steering will be disqualified.

All Engines must be sealed with additional approved security seals to the cylinder head and flywheel/fan cover.

The engine and engine accessories must comply with the Four Stroke Karting Association of NSW 2020 Supplementary Engine Technical Specification, Document ID: 4SKANSW2020SETSREV03.

F. CLUB/TRACK REQUIREMENTS

MEDICAL SERVICES:

Any Medical assistance that is required outside of the operating hours when Karts are not on the Race Track please contact 000. The address to give to the Emergency Services is: Orange Kart Racing Club, Perc Griffith Way, Orange NSW 2800.

KART RETRIEVAL:

Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Race Track area when permitted by the Grid Marshall or Clerk of Course, and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY Safety Vest or Clothing on the upper torso. Any pit crew retrieving a kart must be from that karts team group, team groups must not intermingle at any time.

ANIMALS:

Subject to the applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, no animals are allowed anywhere within the Track precinct, other than Registered Service Dogs.

OTHER:

All persons entering the event are encouraged to have the official COVID-19 App operational on their mobile device whilst attending the event.

Due to restricted space in the pit area, a pit allocation map may be released by the club. Please conform with any pit area allocation and or direction from officials or club committee members regarding the parking of trailers and tow vehicles.

No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.

No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Track.

Overnight camping <u>is permitted</u> at Orange Kart Track. Social distancing requirements must be adhered to at all times.

Please keep the Ambulance gate/entrance clear at all times.
